BACKGROUND About Fort Worth ISD

With an operating budget of \$620,094,569, more than 86,000 students in 83

elementary schools, 29 middle schools and 6th grade centers, 18 high schools and 16



other campuses, Fort Worth ISD enjoys a diverse student population and strong community partnerships. Under the leadership of the superintendent and the Board of Education, the District is undergoing a series of initiatives that will redesign, transform, and revitalize Fort Worth ISD Schools.

THE CHALLENGE

The school district wanted 10,000 laptops of a 22,000 unit order deployed to schools across the district quickly, so the students could start using the computers.
